This is now available, showing results of the 1991 annual census of production reworked to the SIC, revised 1992. The monitor is published by HMSO and is available through government bookshops or through booksellers, price £23.

The first census to be conducted on the basis of SIC(92) will be that for 1993. However, to provide a link between those results published on SIC(80) and those for 1993 and beyond, PA 1002.1 contains a limited range of 1991 data reworked to SIC(92) Section and Sub-Section level.

The annual Home Office Statistical Bulletin on citizenship statistics was published on 16 June 1994. It contains information on grants of British citizenship in the United Kingdom analysed by basis (residence, marriage, etc) and type (discretionary, entitlement), and by previous nationality, for 1993 and earlier years. 46,000 persons were granted British citizenship in the United Kingdom in 1993, and citizens of New Commonwealth countries accounted for over 50 per cent of this total.
