The volume sets out in 37 tables UK-wide data for 1992/93 and previous years on population, finance, teaching staff, schools, curriculum, post compulsory education, further and higher education and qualifications and destinations. The 1994 edition also contains an article covering international comparison work, which updates both the international comparison article featured since 1989 and the EC ERASMUS and LINGUA students programmes and their take up in the UK, featured in the 1993 edition.

### **Statistical bulletin : 1/95 Survey of young people's participation in the Youth Service**

---

This bulletin reports the results of a survey carried out by OPCS between October 1993 and May 1994 as part of their Omnibus Survey. About 3,700 young people aged 11-25 provided details of their current or past participation in a range of youth service activities, on their attitudes to the youth service, and on the other leisure activities in which they were engaged.

This bulletin, which was scheduled for publication in March but is ready for publication slightly ahead of schedule, summarises the results of a sample survey carried out in March 1994. It provides information on the number, type, location and maintenance of information technology equipment; expenditure and sources of funding; the use and contribution of information technology; the level of further advice required; support for information technology; staff training; and use of information technology by pupils with special educational needs.

The annual Home Office Statistical Bulletin on citizenship statistics was published on 16 June 1994. It contains information on grants of British citizenship in the United Kingdom analysed by basis (residence, marriage, etc) and type (discretionary, entitlement), and by previous nationality, for 1993 and earlier years. 46,000 persons were granted British citizenship in the United Kingdom in 1993, and citizens of New Commonwealth countries accounted for over 50 per cent of this total.

## Recently available statistical series and publications

### **Firearm certificate statistics - England and Wales 1993**

This annual bulletin gives information on the issue of firearm and shot gun certificates under the Firearms Acts 1968 to 1992. Details are given of the number of new and renewal applications together with the number of certificates on issue at the end of 1993. Details as to the number of firearms dealers who apply for registration, registrations granted and refused, removals from register etc are also included. All these statistics are given by police force area.

Reference is made to the number of weapons covered by the certificates on issue and information is also provided on visitors' firearm and shot gun permits.

For the first time statistics on European firearm passes and Article 7 authorities are included (the former, broadly speaking, a passport for firearms needed when an EC resident travels to shoot in another EC state and the latter giving authority for a shooter in the EC to purchase firearms of certain types outside his or her State of residence).

### **Motoring offences - England and Wales 1993**

---

This annual bulletin gives statistics on motoring offences dealt with by the police for the years 1983 - 1993, together with summary tables showing the years 1951, 1961, 1971 and 1981. The number of offences dealt with by court proceedings, fixed penalties, written warnings and VDRS schemes are separately shown with details as to court disposals, number of fixed penalties paid and VDRS notices complied with. Information is also included on the use of automatic cameras for road traffic law enforcement.

The associated supplementary tables give more detailed information, for 1993 only, by type of offence, type of court, court disposal (including length of custodial sentence and amount of fine), and police force, for court proceedings, and include details of driving licence disqualifications. Offence type, result and police force are shown for fixed penalty notices.

## 1992 based population projections for Wales

*A booklet containing sub-national projections for Wales covering the period 1992 to 2011 was published by the Welsh Office in December 1994.*

The projections for the counties and district health authorities of Wales are based on the Registrar General's 1992 mid-year estimate of the usually resident population, constrained to be consistent with the Government Actuary's Department projected national totals. The projection is essentially trend based; it does not, for example, make assumptions about the effects of future local or central government policies which might affect population distribution.

A set of projections for the unitary authorities and new health authorities for Wales, consistent with the current projection, will be produced shortly.
